

Student Information for Rising 9th Grade Activity Fairs Friday, March 29, 2019



All 8th grade students scheduled to attend Madison or Marshall HS will attend the activity fair at their assigned school. 8th grade students who are attending Oakton HS will remain at Thoreau MS as Oakton will be sending representatives to review transition information with their rising 9th graders. If you are attending a school other than Madison, Marshall, or Oakton, please see your counselor, Mr. Condill, or Mrs. Campbell.

Permission slips must be returned to science teachers no later than Wednesday, March 20th. Students cannot attend the trip if they do not return the signed permission slip. Bus groups will be posted in the cafeteria as of Tuesday, March 26th.

Madison HS

- 1. Students will dismissed via PA announcement around 9:00. Please leave all items in your locker and report to the following locations:
 - a. Wombats to Eagle Hall
 - b. Falcons to Cafeteria
 - c. Super Sloths to Gym 1
- 2. Students will board the bus around 9:30 and will receive wristbands from the group chaperone. Wristbands must be worn at Madison.
- 3. Students will attend a welcome session in the auditorium from 10:00-10:20.
- 4. Student groups will rotate through 4 sessions from 10:25-11:05.
- 5. Students will regroup in the auditorium at 11:05.
- 6. Students will be dismissed at 11:30 and will return back to Thoreau around 11:45.
- Students should bring a bagged lunch or they can purchase lunch from the cafeteria at Thoreau.
 Students will eat in the cafeteria and Eagle Hall.
- 8. Students will be dismissed to 7th period at 12:13.

Marshall HS

- 1. Students will dismissed via PA announcement around 9:00. Please leave all items in your locker and report to A-109. Bring your lunch or lunch money with you.
- 2. Students will board the bus around 9:30.
- 3. Students will attend a welcome session in the auditorium from 10:00-10:30.
- Lunch will be from 10:30-11:00 in Marshall's cafeteria. Students will need to bring their lunch with them or they can buy a lunch at Marshall for \$3.25. Thoreau lunch codes will not work at Marshall.
- 5. Students will rotate through 2 sessions from 11:05-12:20. Sessions include: clubs/sports in main gym and performing arts production in auditorium.
- 6. Students depart Marshall at 12:30 and will return back to Thoreau around 12:45.
- 7. Students will report to 9th period.

Oakton HS

- 1. Students will remain at Thoreau.
- 2. Students will attend math and elective classes if they are scheduled during 3rd and/or 7th periods.
- 3. Only students who have a core class (English, Civics, Science) during 3rd and/or 7th periods will report to Eagle Hall during that period.
- 4. All students who are attending Oakton HS next year will report to Eagle Hall during Eagle Time (5th period) to meet with representatives from Oakton HS to review transition information. We will provide the group with a pizza lunch in Eagle Hall and then they will return to 7th period at 11:13.
