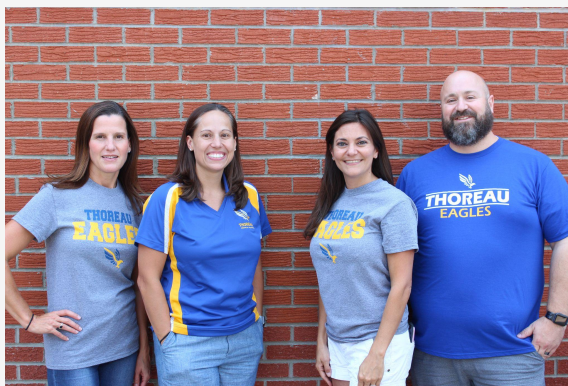

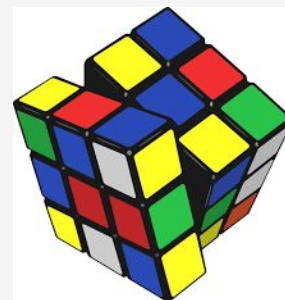

Health & Physical Education (HPE)



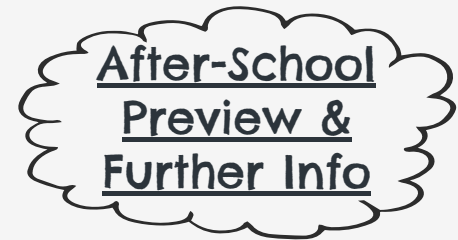
- HPE is a required course for all students
- Students will “dress out” for class
- Students will have access to locker rooms and an HPE locker to store their belongings
- Students are encouraged to purchase a Thoreau HPE uniform but may also use athletic clothing from home that matches the HPE uniform colors
- Athletic shoes are required for HPE
- Our HPE teachers will work with students in the first weeks of school to set expectations and inform them of the steps to purchase a uniform if they select this option
- Financial support is available for children that need it to ensure all students have access to a uniform

- The ASP is free!
- September 19th: First day of after-school activities and late buses
- Club/activity information & weekly club schedules will be posted on Schoology in the coming weeks

Late Bus Information

- Late buses are provided on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.
 - If parents would like to pick their child up from after school, they may do so at any time before 4:45pm at the main office
- Late buses will depart Thoreau at *approximately* 4:30-5:00pm. *Times are subject to change.*
- Late bus runs differ from the morning and afternoon runs. There are fewer buses and stops. Late bus runs will be posted in the front lobby, by the cafeteria, and on Schoology by mid-September.

Recess

FCPS division-wide initiative

- 15 minute daily; prior to lunch
- Outside, weather permitting
- Brief break from academics and opportunity for socialization
- No cell phone use during this time
- Students will be supervised by their 7th or 6th period teacher
- Students will go directly to lunch from recess





Technology

FCPSOn

- Technology used to amplify and support instruction.
- Students will be issued laptops and chargers on the first day of school.
- Highly recommend backpack with laptop pocket.
- Please follow all procedures and have a name tag visible on the laptop



Away for the Day



- Phones must be silenced and kept put away from 7:30 AM-2:15 PM.
- Students are prohibited from using phones, tablets, and other mobile devices in restrooms and locker rooms, unless there is a medical necessity or emergency.
- Storage may be in a locker, backpack, pencil bag, etc., during the day.
- Watches that serve a dual purpose (e.g., smart watch) may be worn; however, phone features (e.g., texting, Internet, calls, etc.) are to be off when phone use is prohibited.
- **Wireless earbuds and headphones are prohibited. Students will need wired headphones to plug directly into their laptop if needed.**
- Teachers may allow usage of cell phones for instructional activities where they are the most appropriate tool, however one-to-one FCPS devices should meet most needs.

Schoology




- FCPS Learning Management Software
- Schoology works with Google Drive
- You will need a SIS/ParentVUE account to login to Schoology
- Students can log in using their FCPS student ID and password.
 - Students will not see any classes until the grading period starts
- As a parent or guardian, you will be able to use Schoology to view: your child's class, assignments and participation, calendar, teacher comments, scores, and feedback

Return to School Logistics

Health and Safety Document

Updates to the Health and Safety Guidance Document have been made in accordance with new guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Virginia Department of Health (VDH), the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE), and the Fairfax County Health Department (FCHD).

Staying Home When Sick: FCPS continues to require families to review the Daily Health Screening before sending students to school. The 5 Day Isolation Period will also continue for COVID positive students and staff.

Health and Safety Document

Supports for Students in Isolation:

StreamIn/CheckIn continues for students who are in isolation due to COVID-19. No later than day three of the isolation, students will be able to access: recording or live streaming of direct instruction for core classes, asynchronous class assignments via Schoology, interactive check-ins with teachers

COVID Case Notifications

FCPS will no longer send a daily or weekly COVID case update. Parents/Guardians will only receive an email from their child's school when many cases of COVID-19 occur in a single classroom, sports team, or extracurricular activity within a 14-day period. Individual case reports will be available on the [FCPS COVID-19 Dashboard](#) on our website.

Cafeteria & Meals

- The only students who will receive free lunch/breakfast are those who qualify.
- Students may not arrive earlier than 7:10 AM. Students may purchase breakfast and eat in the cafeteria.
- MySchoolBucks
- We have seating for 450 students but each lunch has approximately 300 students assigned
- Outdoor eating will be offered, weather and staffing dependent
