Steps to Success Lesson Outline

Slide 1:

-Tell students that today we will be discussing what to do when you miss class.

Slide 2:

-Have students share with a partner what they do when they miss a class or day of school

-Ask for volunteers to share out ideas they discussed with their partner

-Present the bullets and go over them as a class

Slide 3:

-Remind students that they should always check blackboard or google classroom when they are absent.

-Have students turn to page 4 (blue day/gold day schedule) and mark classes that use blackboard with a “b” and those that use google classroom with a “gc”

Slide 4:

-Tell the students “we are going to spend some time talking about and investigating their StudentVUE accounts.” Discuss the items they can see.

-“This is the 2nd year for these accounts in FCPS.”

- Their login is totally separate from their parent’s ParentVUE account.

-“You are being empowered by being allowed access to this information”

-“You should log into your account periodically throughout the year to review the information that is there.”


Slide 5:

Slide 6:

-Practice before-hand going into Blackboard and the Thoreau and FCPS websites to access the StudentVUE login page before demoing to students.

-The search section is in the upper left hand corner of the FCPS website. Type “StudentVue” in the search bar.



-If students have access to computers, allow them time to explore their accounts. If you don't have enough computers for all students, the next slide explains an app that students could download to their phone to access their account.

Slide 7:

-Tell students that there is a StudentVUE app that they can use to access their accounts.

-You can allow them time to download the app on their phone and explore their accounts.

-FYI – there is currently no app for ParentVUE
