About the FCPS World Languages Credit by Exam (WLCBE):

- The exam assesses language proficiency in languages other than English.
- Students who take the exam may earn up to three passing World Languages credits for levels one, two, and/or three for the language of the exam.
- The credits may fulfill the world languages requirements for the Advanced Studies Diploma.
- The FCPS World Languages Credit Exam is also an approved assessment for awarding the Virginia Department of Education's Seal of Biliteracy.
- The exam is offered one time per school year for the languages listed on the FCPS World Languages Credit by Exam website (see below).
- A student may participate in the exam two times per language, once per year, between grades 7 through 12. In other words, students have two chances per language to earn credits by taking the exam.
