

THOREAU LETTER AWARD 2019-2020

The Thoreau letter will be awarded at the end of the school year based on participation and accomplishments in the following areas:

- Academic recognition
- Service to the community
- Extracurricular activities



Students must accumulate a total of 150 points to earn a Thoreau Letter. *Note that the required total number of points has been reduced to account for school closures for during the final quarters of the school year.*

Listed below are *examples* of activities and recognition students may include on their Thoreau Letter Award application. Each item will have a value of 10 points and may be used per quarter as appropriate (e.g. honor roll could be calculated for each quarter in which it is earned).

Examples of Academic Recognition:

ALL A or A/B Honor Roll Student of the Quarter Identification for Participation in District Band, Orchestra or Chorus Team Recognition Other Academic Recognition

Examples of Extracurricular Activities:

Publication Staff (Newspaper, Yearbook, Literary Arts Magazine) Theatre Productions (Cast and Crew) SCA Representative Eagle Morning News Staff Music Performances (Band, Orchestra, Chorus) Intramurals Music Solo or Ensemble Participant Other Extra-curricular Activities
